1. All entries must be made on English/Western Horse Show entry forms either online via **AssistExpo** or emailed to horse.donkey@ricevillefair.ca on or before August 26, 2026. This will be the last year that entries will be accepted the day of the show at no cost.
No entry fee will be refunded.

2. All entry fees must be paid the day of the show.

3. All prize money will be mailed. Please provide a complete mailing address.

4. All Exhibitors must show proof of current insurance policy noting comprehensive **liability coverage – Minimum \$2,000,000.00.**

5. Lead line exhibitors must be able to sit unaided in the saddle. Lead line handler must be 16 years or older. Lead line exhibitors cannot enter other riding classes.

6. Peewee exhibitors are 12 years old and under as of January 1, 2026. Coach will be permitted in the ring.

7. Youth exhibitors are 13 to 18 years old as of January 1, 2026.

8. Senior exhibitors are 19 years and older as of January 1, 2026, and are required to pay a \$10.00 membership fee unless retained from last year's prize money.

9. A Youth may not enter a senior event.

10. A horse used by a youth in a youth event may be used by a senior in a senior event or vice versa.

11. Riders may ride more than one horse in a class.

12. All English/Western exhibitors are to be dressed in clean and appropriate attire. All riders 18 years and younger must wear a helmet with chin strap done up. A senior will not be disqualified if they wish to wear a helmet.

13. Classes 10 to 24 western tack only.

14. Riding crops may be used in English Classes. Horses may not be hit with bats, crops, quirts, whips or ends of reins. Any excessive spurring or whipping will not be allowed.

NOTE: A.Q.H.A. rules will be applied. In the event of any contradictions, rules 1 to 14, will prevail.

The Judge's Decision will be final.

NOTE: Although negative Coggins test results are not required for horse entries, it is recommended that exhibitors have all horses fully vaccinated and Coggins tests for the protection of themselves and other exhibitors.

NOTE: Please note that parking will no longer be available near the weigh scale to enable the trucks access on/off the scale. Parking is also not available south of the pine tree due to the Country Market Vendors.

Class List and Order of Go

Crops, spurs, over and under will be allowed. The Judge at their discretion may disqualify an exhibitor for excessive use.
