Rules and Regulations

1. Livestock Exhibitors must provide proof of \$1,000,000 liability insurance or entries will be refused.
2. All general rules and regulations of the fair will apply.
3. Entries must be received by August 26, 2026 and to entered on AssistExpo or emailed to cattle@ricevillefair.ca on the fair entry form included in the prize list.
4. In lieu of entry fees, 15% will be deducted from all prize money, if any.
5. All exhibitors must sign the declaration of liability insurance form at the bottom of the Livestock Entry Form.
6. All animals exhibited must be registered and must be entered in the records of the applicable Breed Association in the name of the Exhibitor, except for Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire classes.
7. Each animal will be checked against its pedigree and production records prior to entry into the ring.
8. A maximum of two (2) substitute animals will be permitted.
9. All animals to be exhibited must be on the grounds at least two hours before show time. Bedding and feed will not be provided, stalls are free but cannot be held for an exhibitor.
10. Please be considerate of barn space. All Exhibitors must remain until the completion of the show.

ALL ANIMALS MUST HAVE RFID TAGS IN EARS

Class 1. Bull Calf born on or after Jan. 1, 2026, minimum 3 months of age on day of judging.

Class 2. Bull, yearling, born Jan. 1, 2025 to Dec. 31, 2025

Class 3. Senior Bull, born Jan. 1, 2024, to Dec. 31, 2024

Class 4. Female, calf, born on or after Jan. 1, 2026, minimum 3 months of age on day of judging.

Class 5. Female, heifer, born March 1, 2025, to Dec. 31, 2025 (Junior Yearling)

Class 6. Female, senior heifer, born Jan. 1, 2025, to February 28, 2025 (Senior Yearling)

Class 7. Female, born Jan. 1, 2021 to Dec. 31, 2023, with her own 2026, natural, purebred, tattooed, registered calf at foot.

Class 8. Female, born prior to Jan. 1, 2021, with her own 2026, natural, purebred, registered calf at foot.

Supreme Female - \$75.00

Supreme Male - \$75.00 plus Rosettes

Class 9. Breeder's Herd - A group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes to be represented, and must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor

Class 10. Get of Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire, both sexes to be represented. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor, limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor. **Will need papers for this class.** Animals must be shown in one of the previous classes.
